

## CUSTOMS UNION: NORTH TRIANGLE

A Customs Union Agreement was signed by Guatemala and Honduras on February 26, to expedite people and goods traffic at the common borders of the three Central American countries belonging to the North Triangle (Honduras, Guatemala and El Salvador).

The document was signed by presidents Juan Orlando Hernández from Honduras, and Otto Pérez Molina from Guatemala, upon the completion of the First Meeting of the Alliance for the Prosperity of the Northern Triangle of Central America. The agreement is part of a process of deep integration focused towards the free movement of people and goods between the republics of Guatemala and Honduras.

The customs integration process will culminate on December 1, 2015, when it is expected that customs is fully unified to facilitate trade.
