

NEW CONVENTION CENTER IN COSTA RICA

In early April, the President Luis Guillermo Solís inaugurated the National Congress and Convention Center (CNCC). The new CNCC contemplates a main building with an area of 15,600 sqm, located 8km away from Juan Santamaria International Airport and 10 km away from downtown San Jose; the building has a with maximum capacity of 4,600 people.

The architecture and design of the new convention center was build taking into consideration the strictest sustainable standards, in accordance to the green image of the country, and offers spaces for expos, convention rooms, parking, outdoors events area, etc.

The CNCC will allow the Tourism Institute to venture in the meetings tourism sector, participating in renowned specialized fairs and generating alliances with important organisms such as the International Congress and Convention Association and the Confederation of Organizers of Congresses in Latin America.

It's expected that this new facility thrusts businesses across all industries improving the countries competitive environment.
