

NICARAGUA WILL LAUNCH AN ONLINE SINGLE WINDOW FOR FOREIGN TRADE

The Single Window of Foreign Trade of Nicaragua (VUCEN for its acronym in Spanish) will be fully functional in the upcoming months to facilitate the issuance of permits and documents that are required to carry out imports and exports. Through VUCEN, the companies will be able to carry out procedures electronically, quickly and safely.


To use the platform, the interested party must complete a format, which will work as a pre-registration that will generate a username and password that will grant access to the platform. The user will have the facility to access from a single platform to the different government institutions, such as: Customs Authority (DGA, for its acronym in Spanish), Ministry of Health (MINSA, for its acronym in Spanish), the Institute of Agricultural Protection and Health (IPSA, for its acronym in Spanish), make online payments in the national banking system, among others.

This new digital system will facilitate the import and export processes, since the pre-customs process will be submitted in a single digital platform, with the advantage of being able to submit the application documents in digital copies. Once the previous process has been completed, the information will be sent directly to the corresponding customs department to inform the import or export process that the users are carrying out.

The web address to access the platform is: www.vucen.gob.ni. This new digital platform will be linked to the Central American digital commerce platform to facilitate trade between the Central American countries.
